Unlike traditional Shakespeare though, our interpretation of how the story unfolded was...a little bit different and included all things circus as well as a drag queen, pole dancers, light sabres, ball gags, a baby and some milkshakes (kinda).

Performing over 8 consecutive nights inside the Big Top in the Northbridge Pleasure Garden, we were able to successfully sell out 4 of the 8 shows - and we have been reliably informed that the other nights were very close to selling out too.
